Louis N. Teti is a Past President of the Pennsylvania Bar Association. He graduated from Dickinson College in 1972 (B.A., Political Science) and Temple University School of Law (J.D., 1976; LL.M., Taxation, 1981). He has served on the Board of Directors of the Laymen's Retreat League (Malvern), is a past President of the Chester County Estate Planning Council, and a past Chairman of the Annual Campaign at Paoli Hospital. He is Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Foundation at Paoli Hospital.

Mr. Teti is a Past President of the Chester County Bar Foundation, and he is a Life Fellow of the American Bar Foundation and the Pennsylvania Bar Foundation. He is currently Vice President of the Pennsylvania Bar Foundation, and he was the recipient of two PBA Special Achievement Awards for his work as Chairman of the PBA Long Range Planning Committee. He currently serves as Co-Chairman of the PBA Law Related Education Committee.
